

The yellow polygon encompasses the area we'll use for digitizing landcover and buildings. Note that it follows road centerlines, approximately, except for the northeast corner, where it follows the edge of a building and then across a lawn/walkways to a street. Digitize to approximately the middle of each road, and along the building edge then to the road near the northeast corner of the area.

The red, dotted polygon encompasses the area for which you will digitize individual tree canopies. Each crown should be separate, try to distinguish individual crowns among the clumps. It doesn't have to be exact, as it is difficult to distinguish the differences between trees, but do the best you can in a reasonable amount of time (e.g., no more than two hours of digitizing on trees).
