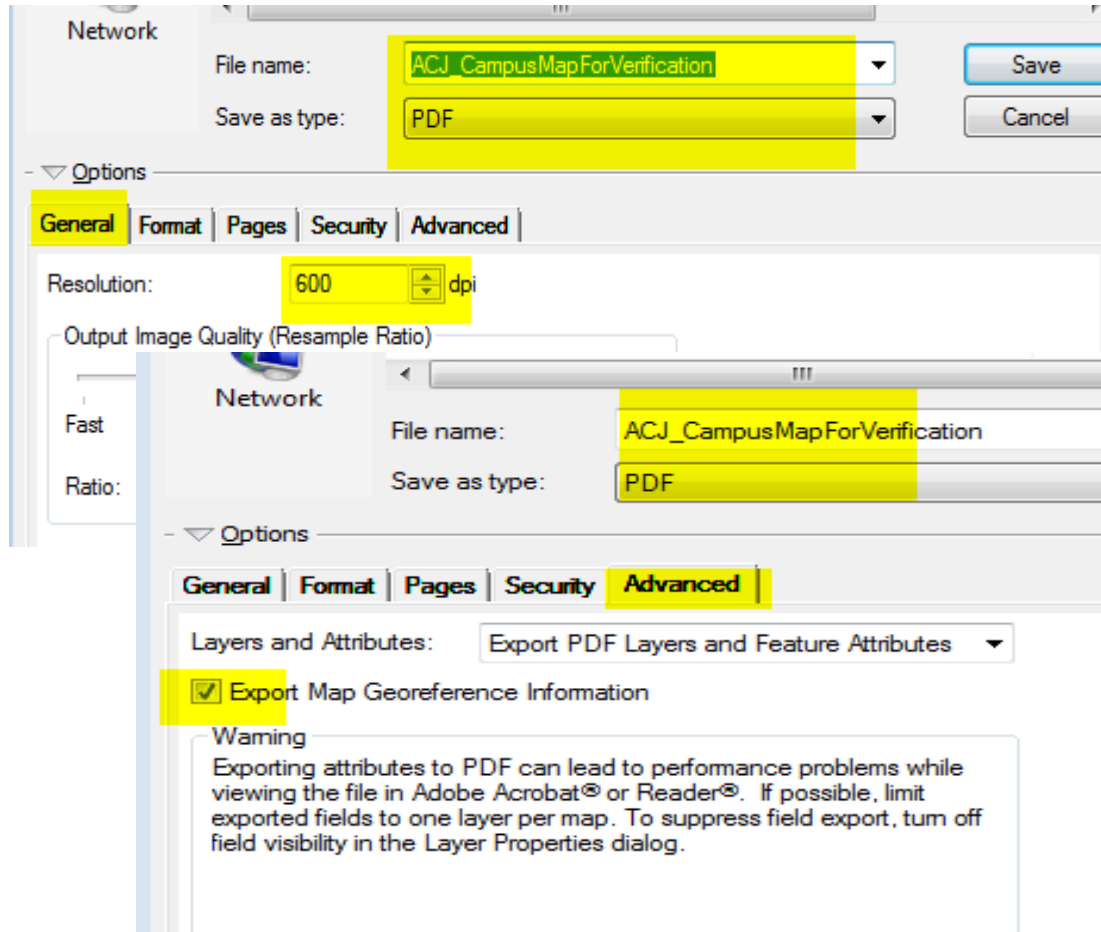
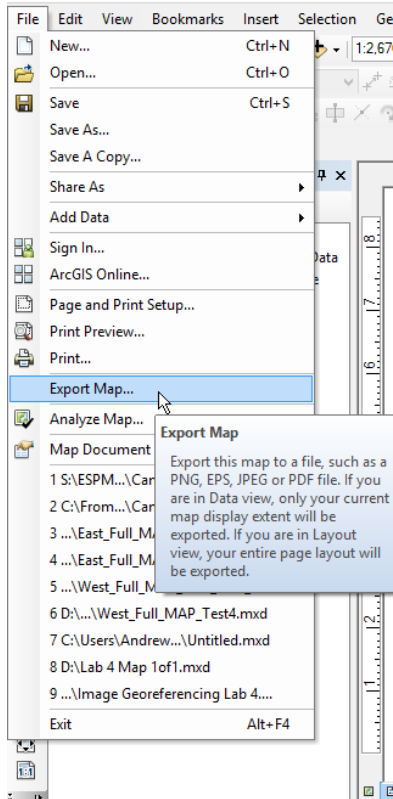


# Geospatial PDF

- Several years ago Adobe expanded their PDF format to include geospatial information.
- If geospatial information is added to a PDF (when created) it can be accessed via any up to date Adobe Reader or Acrobat  
(note many applications have simple PDF viewers; these do you yet support the new Adobe geospatial functions)
- These geospatial enabled PDF's are called Geospatial PDF's
- The easy way to create a Geospatial PDF is to use ArcMap or QGIS; after you have set up the Map Composer or Layout, export the Map using with the Georeferencing Option enabled.

# Geospatial PDF (in ArcMap)

Export to a PDF with high DPI and Advanced → Georeference Information checked



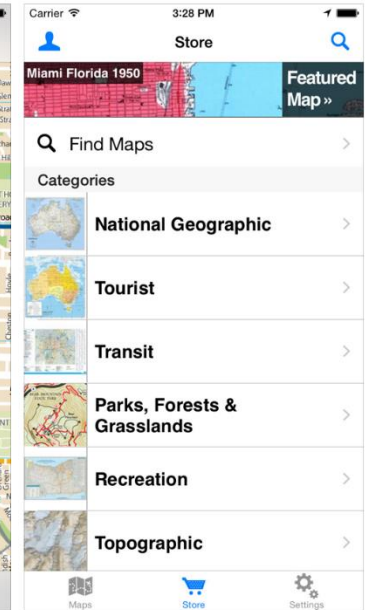
Warning  
Exporting attributes to PDF can lead to performance problems while viewing the file in Adobe Acrobat® or Reader®. If possible, limit exported fields to one layer per map. To suppress field export, turn off field visibility in the Layer Properties dialog.

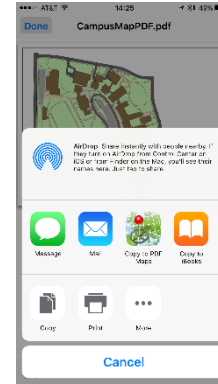
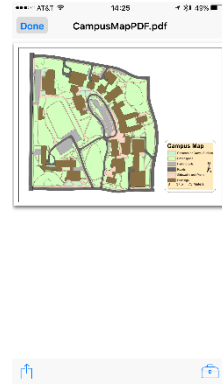
After installing PDF Maps to your iOS or Android device:

Add the PDF to your PDF Maps application via email or a web link.

Via Email:

Email PDF to yourself and open the attachment in the PDF Maps application. The map will be stored within the PDF Maps application so you do not need to keep the email used for loading.

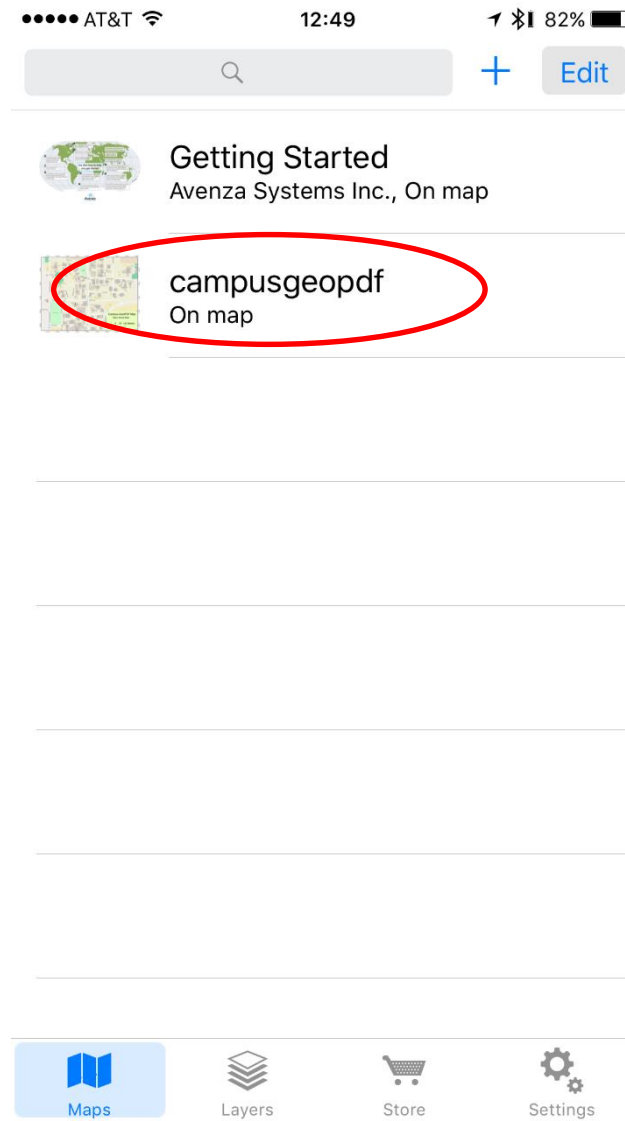


Open the PDFMaps app

# Open the campusgeopdf

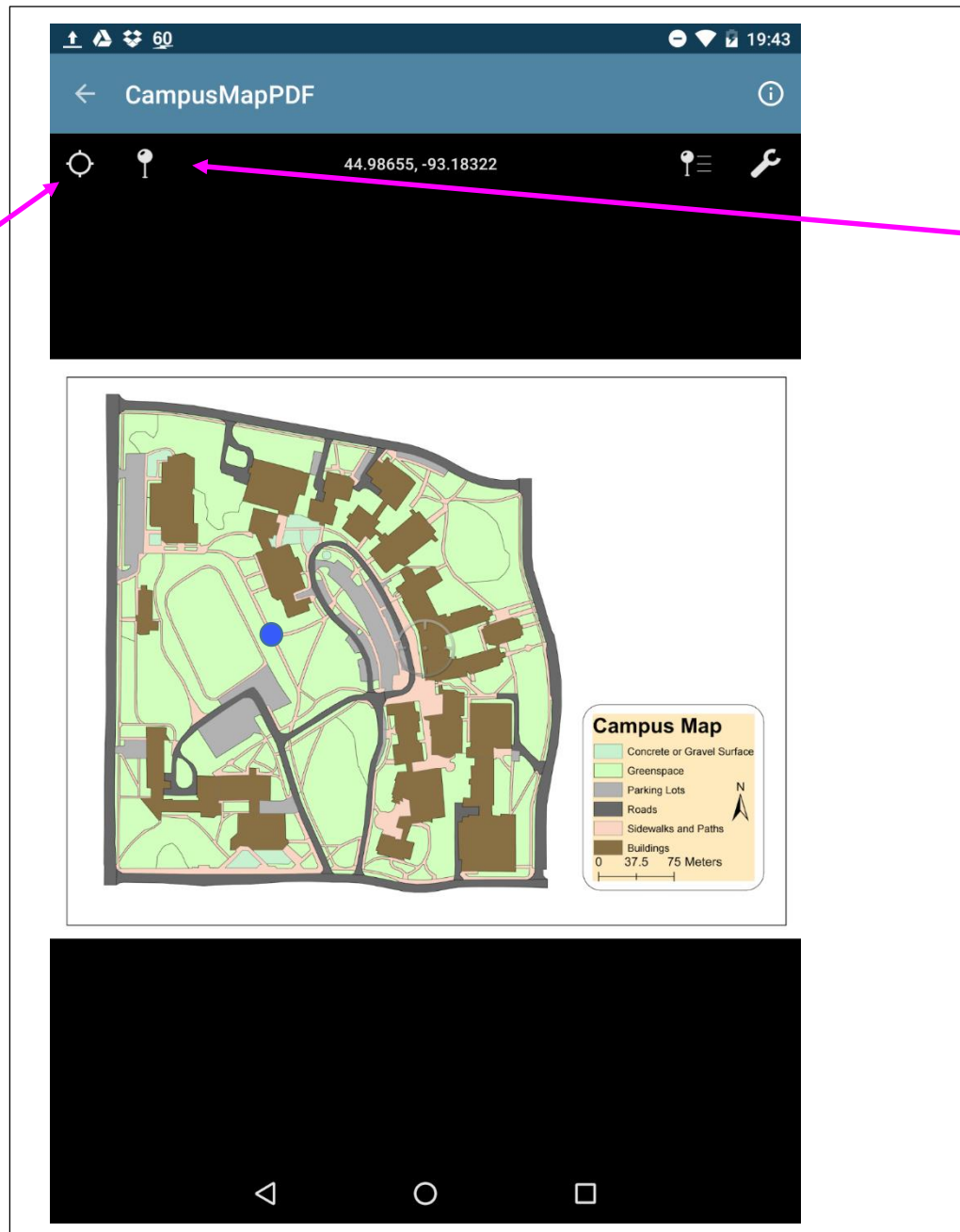

To use PDF Maps  
Select the Location
